In order to optimize the administration of collection of septic tanks etc., EnviDan has developed a unique digital system for registration and control of collection of septic sludge and the connected collection scheme..

EnviTriX is an integrated solution that enables you to register and send relevant information directly between mobile units and a central database through GPRS. Using this system, the collector can automatically save essential information for later registration. The process will be handled quickly and effectively and save time.

To ensure user-friendliness, EnviTriX provides a web based interface fully accessible for the Utility Company and municipality, and tailored access for collectors and citizens. EnviTriXCar can be installed as mobile units in trucks.

#### You get all this with EnviTriX:

- Transfer of municipal property data (septic tank location, owner addresses, etc.) directly to EnviTriX.
- Tailored access and web based surface for Utility Company/municipality, collector and citizen.
- Possibility for manual registration of additional collection executed by another collector. Module for managing the collection scheme.
- Role based access to webpages, which can be administered by the administrator.
- Module for managing payment for the services
- Module with different filtering- and report options. E.g. filtering of addresses where:
  - Collection were not completed in time.
  - Collection was impossible and the reason why
- Tailored data extraction for GIS.
- Possibility for handling error reported tanks:
  - Required action depends on registered reason.
  - After response concerning remedial maintenance, the tank can be released for emptying again.
- Continuously updated two-way communication between EnviTriX and EnviTriXCar.
- Historic on addresses for emptying (time for completed/not completed emptying with indication of relevant belonging data and notes.)
